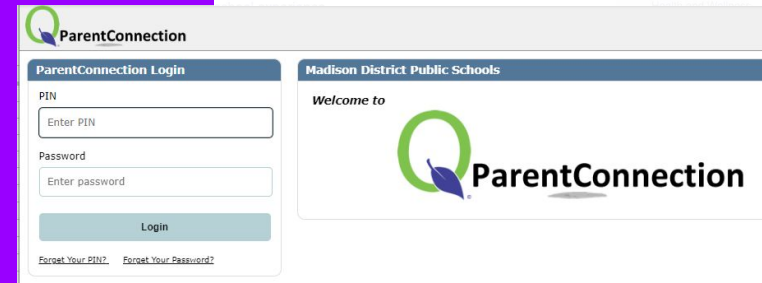



- Broken Chromebook

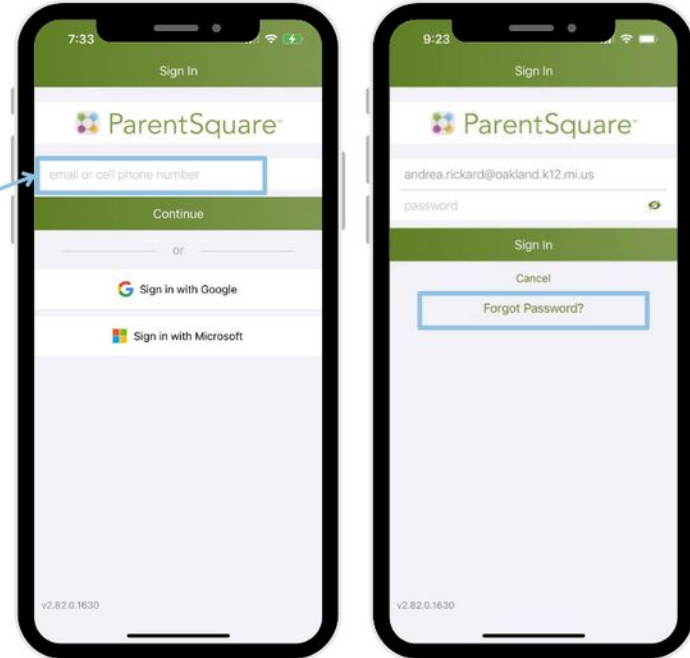

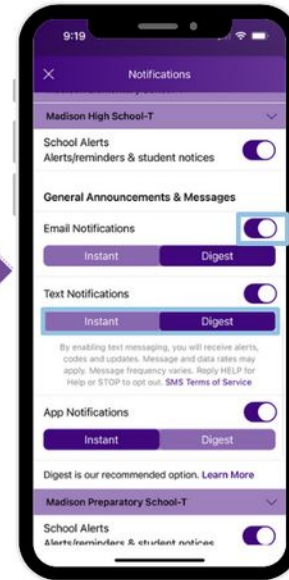
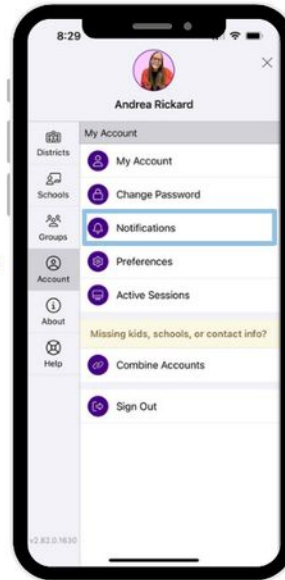
PARENT SQUARE: SIGNING IN

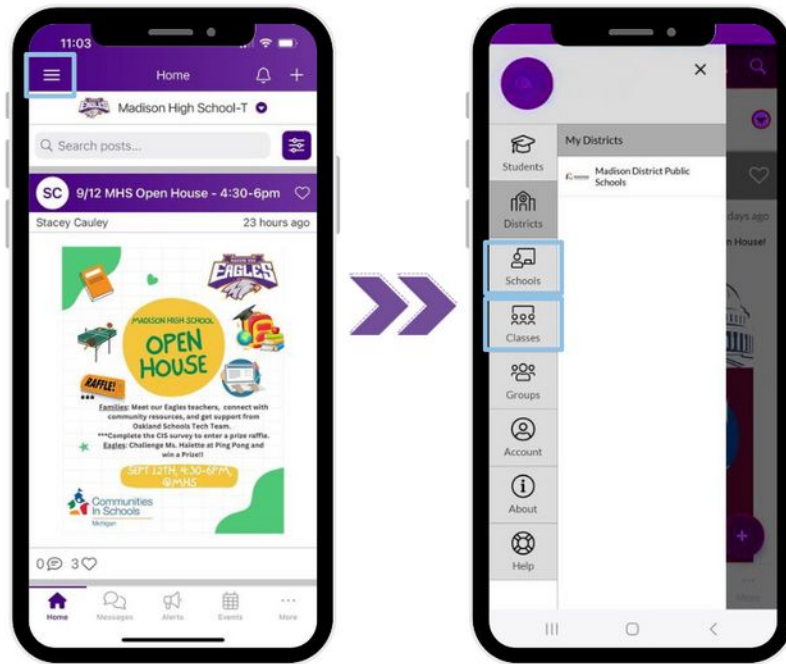
PARENT SQUARE: NOTIFICATIONS

Importance of Regular Attendance: Regular attendance is KEY to academic achievement, and participation in class instruction, discussion & learning experiences cannot be replaced

Tardy Policy/Hall Sweeps: Being prompt and prepared for each class every hour is imperative! Consequences escalate from a warning to lunch detention to after school detention + loss of privileges to ISS to OSS and Oakland County Attendance Officer referral

Truancy: The Michigan Compulsory Attendance Law requires students under 18 years of age to attend school. When a child has more than 10 absences in a semester, whether excused or unexcused, it is considered excessive and may be investigated.
